

Curriculum Overview for Oak Class

English Writing Persuasive Writing The children will learn the different attributes of persuasive writing. They will then write two different letters using the techniques taught, including repetition and hyperbole. On the run up to the SATs tests we will look at the Grammar paper to refresh the children’s memory. Spelling The children will continue to learn the statutory spellings. This term we will be learning about the suffixes, exploring the different ways they can be spelt. We will also continue to focus on any gaps for previous year groups. Reading The children will have daily guided reading lessons and answer questions on a range of different genres to help improve their comprehension. Handwriting increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting, ensuring that the downstrokes of letters are parallel and that lines of writing are spaced sufficiently so that the ascenders and descenders of letters do not touch.			Art & Design Global Food The children will be given the chance to discover the exciting and diverse choice of food available around the world. The first part of the unit provides an opportunity for children to learn where in the world a variety of ingredients flourish. They will then build on their understanding of the eatwell plate, placing different ingredients into the correct food groups. Computing Creating media - Introduction to vector graphics In this unit, learners start to create vector drawings. They learn how to use different drawing tools to help them create images. Learners recognise that images in vector drawings are created using shapes and lines, and each individual element in the drawing is called an object. Learners layer their objects and begin grouping and duplicating them to support the creation of more complex pieces of work	
Mathematics Algebra Begin to write equations to express situations. Use simple formulae to generate, express and describe: - linear number sequences - mathematical formula - missing number, lengths, coordinates and angles problems - equivalent expressions ($a + b = b + a$) - find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns - find all possibilities of combinations of two variables Perimeter, Area, Volume - recognise that shapes with the same areas can have different perimeters and vice versa. - calculates the area of parallelograms and triangles - recognise when it is possible to use the formulae for the area of shapes - calculate, estimate and compare volume of cubes and cuboids using standard units - recognise when it is possible to use the formulae for the volume of shapes Metric / imperial measures - use, read, write and convert between standard units, converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time from a smaller unit of measure to a larger unit, and vice versa, using decimal notation of up to three decimal places - convert between miles and kilometres			PSHE Relationships: What is mental health; My mental health; Love and loss; Power and Control; Being Online; Using Technology responsibly. Changing me: My Self Image; Puberty; Babies (Conception to birth); Boyfriends and Girlfriends; Real Self and Ideal self; The Year Ahead. Science Animals Including Humans This unit will focus on biology and the children will be taught to: Describe the changes as humans develop from birth to old age. Explain the changes that takes place in boys and girls during puberty. Explain how a baby changes physically as it grows and also what it is able to do.
