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Dear Parents,

Happy New Year, we hope you all had a lovely Christmas and we are delighted to welcome back all the children and we look forward to having an exciting and successful term. We would like to communicate a few pieces of helpful information

Wellies

Now it is winter, it gets very muddy and as a rural site the children can get quite muddy when playing outside. Please make sure your child has the correct sized wellies as their feet may have grown since September.

Clothes

Now the weather is getting much colder please can we remind parents to send their child in with a hat and gloves as it can get rather cold during the lunch time play outside.

No toys from home

There are plenty of toys in Acorn class and we ask parents/carers to leave children's toys at home to ensure they don't get broken or cause disagreements between the children.

Reading Books and Library books

Reception Children will continue to take home a Little Wandle Reading book on Thursdays which must be brought back to school the following Tuesday, in their reading folders. They will also have homework sent home on Thursday to consolidate their learning.

All children will have the opportunity to choose a library book to share at home on a Friday. Please ensure that the book is returned by the following Friday so that they can exchange their book for a new one.

Naming belongings

Please ensure that ALL of your child's belongings are named including water bottles and spare clothes, so that we help ensure that they are returned to the correct person.

Tapestry

Please could we ask you to regularly check Tapestry for updates on your child's learning journal and for any messages we may communicate with you. We will endeavour to reply to any comments as quickly as possible. You can like and comment on observations that we have made and it's also possible for you to add your own observations. We very much encourage this as it gives us a different view of your child's learning. Your comments and own observations will allow us to find out about which activities your child really enjoyed and the learning they get up to at home.

Home Time

Please can you ensure that you come directly to the gate to collect your child, as we may at times need to speak to you about your child. This is made easier if everyone is ready to collect their child from the gate once their name has been called.
