Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have all had a restful Easter Holidays. We would like to communicate a few reminders and new pieces of helpful information for the Summer Term.

P.E

Is on Mondays and Fridays. Please ensure your child arrives dressed in their P.E kit on this day please ensure they are dressed in jogging bottoms and a hoodie also.

Water Bottles

As we are now in Summer term and the weather is improving, please could you ensure that your child brings a water bottle to school every Monday. We will keep them in school, re-fill them each day and send them home on a Friday for a wash. If your child has a packed lunch which contains a drink, could you also send a separate bottle so that your child has easy access to it in class.

Clothes

Now the weather is getting much warmer we often have water available to play with. Please could you ensure that your child has a spare set in school in case their clothes get wet and they need to change. The children also require spare clothes in the case of toilet accidents. Please can you ensure that Acorn clothes are returned to us if your child needs to borrow as we quickly become low on spares.

During warmer and sunnier days, please send a named sun hat in for them also.

Reading Books

Reception Children will continue to take home a Little Wandle Reading book on **Thursdays** which must be brought back to school the following **Tuesday**, in their reading folders.

The next set of Tricky words will be sent home before half term. Please could you ensure that your child practises recognising and reading these words regularly. You could use them as flash cards, play tricky word bingo or write out another set and play pairs matching games with them.

All children will have the opportunity to choose a picture book to share at home on a Friday. Please ensure that the book is returned on the following Friday so that they can exchange their book for a new one.

Naming belongings

Please ensure that ALL of your child's belongings are named including water bottles and spare clothes, so that we help ensure that they are returned to the correct person.

Tapestry

Please could we ask you to regularly check Tapestry for updates on your child's learning journal and for any messages we may communicate with you. We will endeavour to reply to any comments as quickly as possible. We have really enjoyed seeing some of your photos and videos of special moments, please continue to do this.

Sun Cream

If the weather becomes exceptionally hot and sunny over the Summer Term, please ensure that your child comes to school with sun cream applied.

If you feel they need a top up during the day, please ensure that they have their own sun cream and that it is labelled. They must also be confident to apply it themselves. A roll-on sun cream is recommended. Please remind your child that it is for their use only and not to share with friends.
