Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our festive celebrations this year, we will be taking our KS1 and KS2 children to BEAM, Hertford to see the pantomime Jack and the Beanstalk. The performance will be in the afternoon of Wednesday 9th December. The children will have lunch in school and then be transported to the theatre by coach.

Nursery and Reception children will have their very own Christmas party afternoon in school. More details to follow nearer the time.

We are very grateful to FoLM for supporting the trip, ensuring that costs are kept as low as possible. However, we still need parental contributions of £12.50 per child to make this trip viable. Please use Arbor (Activities/Trips/Panto 2026) to make your payment by 9am on Monday 19th October.

We are asking for payment and confirmation of your child's place on this exciting trip so early in order to give the theatre our final numbers by the end of October. Unfortunately, we had a number of unused tickets last year and we hope to avoid this happening again.

In order to keep costs to a minimum, coach travel has been arranged from school to the theatre but parents are requested to collect children after the pantomime from Hartham Common, Hertford. Staff will meet parents by the skateboard ramp, at 4pm. There is a car park at Hartham Common (post code SG14 1QR) where it should be possible to park free of charge for 20 minutes. If you make arrangements for someone else to collect your child, please ensure that you notify school in advance.

The price of the ticket includes an ice cream during the interval. Parents of children with allergies or specific dietary needs, who will be unable to eat the ice-cream provided at the theatre, may provide a suitable alternative (labelled with your child's name).
